


PROSPECTUS



ARMY PUBLIC SCHOOL PATIALA

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HISTORY

Established on 26th June 1985, at Old Cantt. location near Hanuman Mandir, the Army School, Patiala was inaugurated by Maj. Gen. DK Mehta, GOC, 1 Armd Div with an initial strength of 334 students studying in classes I to V. Classes VI, VII and VIII were added later.

In 1993, both Primary Wing & Senior Wing were shifted to 40, Baradari Patiala. Due to increased strength, a new Primary Wing was simultaneously created at Tarapore Enclave and later upgraded to Senior Secondary level with the first batch of Class XII passing out in the year 1996. However, till 2000, two separate Primary Wings of the Army School continued to function at Tarapore Enclave and Lal Bagh respectively before being merged together and brought to Rajindra Lines.

From 2000 to 2007, the two wings i.e. Senior Wing & Primary Wing functioned from 40, Baradari and Rajindra Lines separately while construction of the new school premises at Tarapore Enclave started in March 2004. Both wings were shifted to their permanent location in Oct 07 and the school was re-named as Army Public School, Patiala

The new premises of Army Public School, Patiala was inaugurated by Lt. Gen. TK Sapru, YSM, GOC-in-C, Western Command on 18th March 2008.



Admission

Class 1

The minimum age for admission to class I is five years as on 31 March of the year in which admission is sought. No entrance test is administered.

Upto Class IX

Normal Admission to all classes is made during the months Feb-Mar for the ensuing academic session. The students are required to take an entrance test and an interview, to assess the entrant level and are thereafter granted admission to the appropriate class purely on merit. Children of Defence Personnel are, however, granted admission throughout the year.

Class X and XII

Admission to these classes is granted only in case of transfer of parents as per CBSE rules & regulations and on merit basis only. The decision of the school management in such cases is final and binding.

Class XI

The admissions are considered on the basis of the merit list of class X examination and the criteria given by AWES.

Streams Offered in XI & XII

The school offers admission to the following streams of subjects :

Science (Non-Medical)

(with or without Mathematics)



- English, Business Studies, Accountancy, Economics, Informatics Practices/ Mathematics/ Physical Education

NOTE TO THE PARENTS

- (a) The School follows a six days week and remains closed on every first Saturday & third Saturday of the month. Parents must ensure that their children reach the school punctually in neat & clean school uniform.
- (b) The teacher should not be disturbed while the class is in progress
- (c) Parent Teacher Meetings are organised on the last Saturday of every month to facilitate better interaction between teachers and parents.
- (d) Students should not bring costly articles, viz watches, rings, bangles, mobiles etc. to the school. The school does not take any responsibility in case of loss of such articles.
- (e) Parents are requested to restrict the pocket money of their wards.
- (f) The possession of the Student Diary is mandatory. Parents are requested to go through the diary at least once a week and use this as a means of communication with the school/teacher and also for monitoring the progress of their wards.
- (g) Parents should not encourage the unruly behaviour of the child, rather try to take the advice of the school authorities & the counsellor to help the child.

LEAVE RULES

- ◆ Students are not allowed to be absent from school without a previously approved leave application, failing which he/she will be marked absent and fine imposed.
